

# **MNN'S ADMINISTRATIVE AREAS**

*At the general meeting of Music Nest Norway (MNN) on December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022, it was decided that MNN can manage the members' rights in the areas below.*

## **ADMINISTRATIVE AREAS**

In accordance with point 4.1 of the articles of association, a member must transfer to MNN "[...] a non-exclusive right to manage the member's rights to audio recordings and music video rights within areas that the general meeting adopts in accordance with Section 20 of the Intellectual Property Act as well as acquired rights pursuant to Section 16 (or equivalent provisions when amending the Copyright Act). Furthermore, the members grant the Association the right to manage other rights to the extent that the general meeting decides and to the extent that it is necessary to manage the rights mentioned in this point 4.1".

In principle, the administration does not cover areas that must be regarded as the music producers' core business (e.g., streaming from company to consumer and sale/production of physical copies in retail). The board decides from agreement area to agreement area whether the area falls under MNN's mandate, so that MNN can continuously enter into license agreements and manage the rights holders' collective remuneration.

MNN's administration does not cover the music producers' rights to the extent that these are covered by Section 21 of the Copyright Act (which are covered by Gramo).
